Daycare Governing Board Report-September 28, 2022

Beacon Hill Daycare has had a successful beginning to the school year. Our numbers continue to climb as we all get back to regular post-pandemic life. We are currently up to 135 students in Daycare. We now have only one Daycare door for drop off and pick up at the side of the building, closest to Alton Rd and Harwood Gate, and we continue to use the HopHop app. We offer homework periods, gym time, library time, cooking, science and outdoor playtime as part of our program. We have started a leadership program for our oldest group, which currently involves helping with K4/K5 groups and will eventually incorporate other activities. We look forward to a fun filled year at Beacon Hill Daycare including offsite ped days and many different activites.

Daycare Events

Pizza day continues to be a success – thank you to Home and School and the lunch staff for organizing and distributing the pizza. Always a favorite lunch for the students!
